## Map / Directions

The hotel's river ferry provides complimentary access to Canary Wharf as well as connecting Guests to water taxi fleets for a voyage on the Thames, straight into central London. The hotel is ideally located for the O2, Canary Wharf Business and Shopping Centre, Green Park and Oxford Street and only a 10-minute drive from Tower Bridge. Take the C10 bus outside the hotel to Canada Water Station for the Jubilee Line and London Overground, offering quick access to tourist attractions and shopping.

The hotel's river ferry provides complimentary access to Canary Wharf as well as connecting Guests to water taxi fleets for a voyage on the Thames, straight into central London.

From London City Airport, the journey by taxi to DoubleTree by Hilton Hotel London - Docklands Riverside takes about 20 minutes.

We have a secure hotel car park with facilities for up to 100 cars. Use the large forecourt to easily pick up and drop off hotel guests. **Self-parking fees are £15 per overnight stay.**

Our complimentary ferry service to Canary Wharf Pier puts you in short walking distance to Canary Wharf tube and DLR station. The ferry operates approximately every 10 minutes 7 days a week.

For guests who wish to use the Canada Water tube and over-ground station, the C10 public bus stops outside our hotel, which is announced and displayed as DoubleTree by Hilton London - Docklands Riverside.

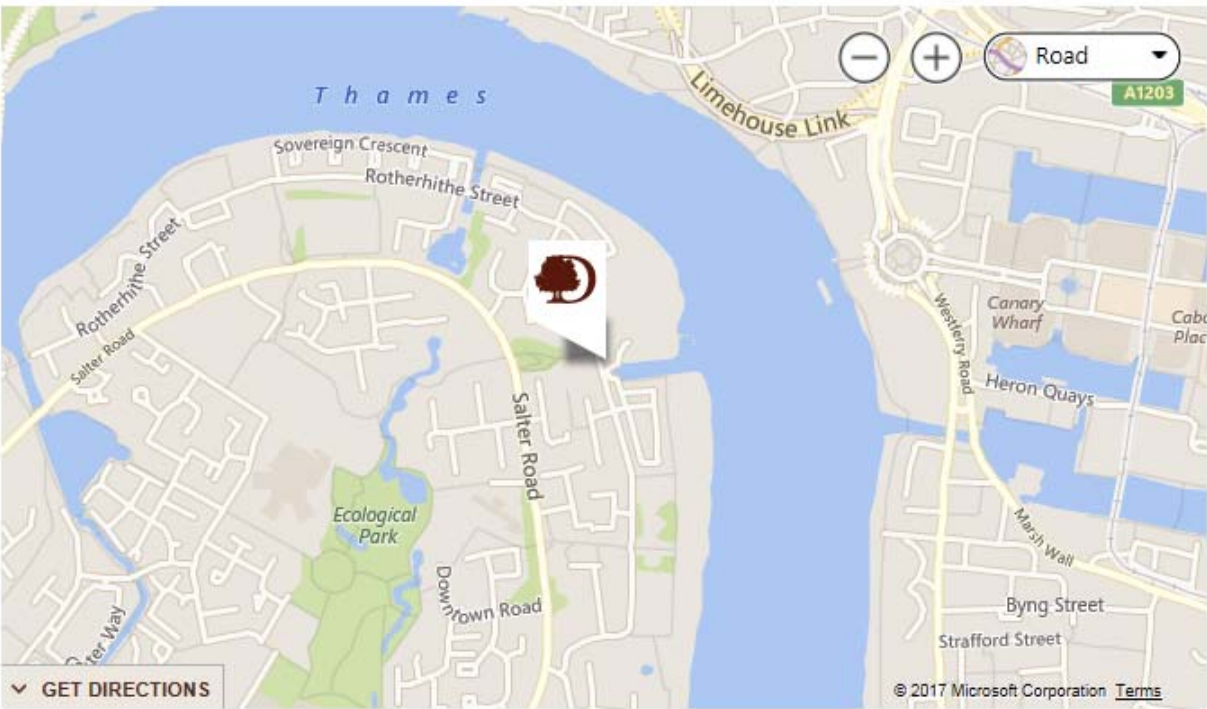

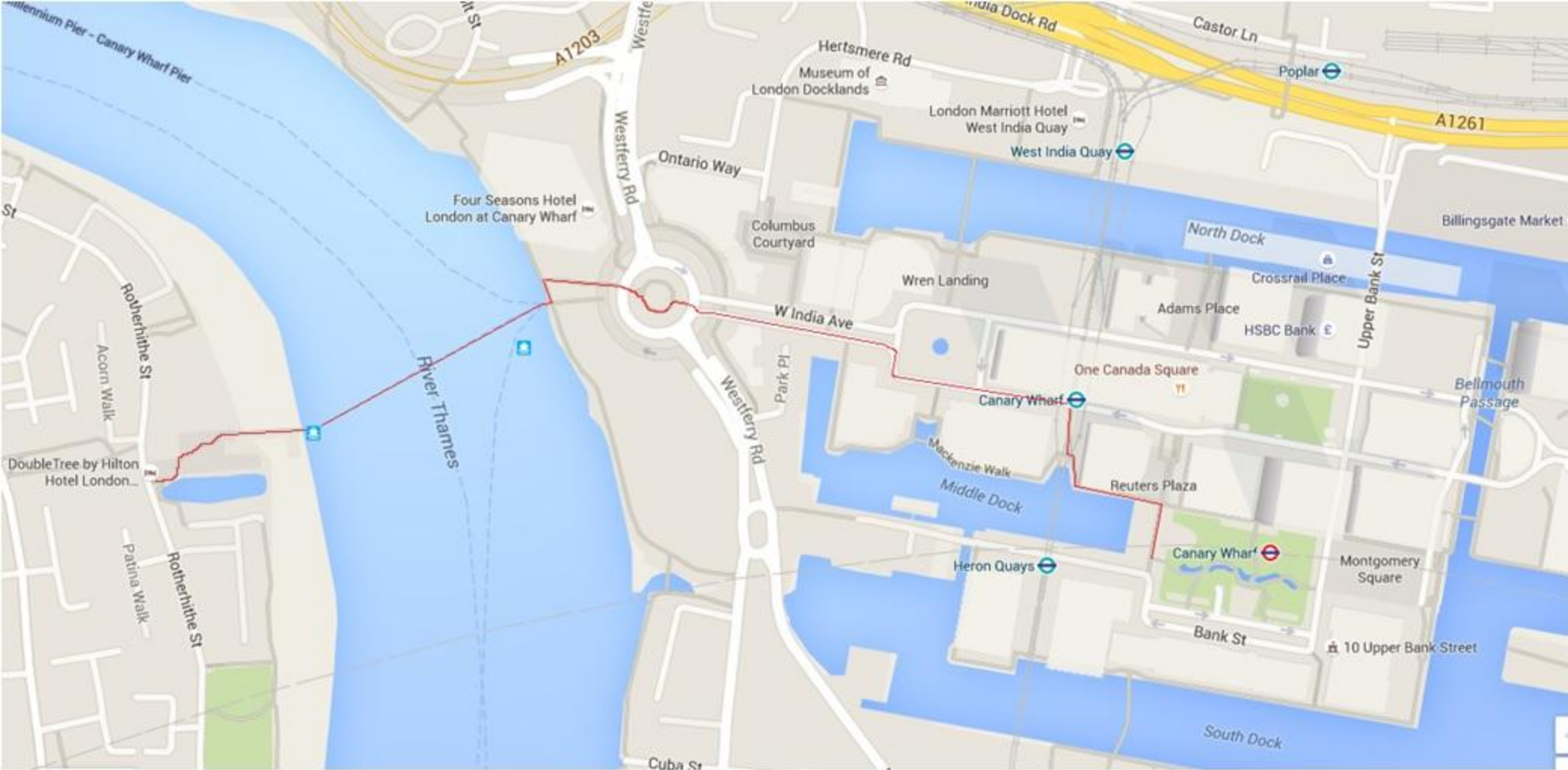

## *From Canary Wharf to DoubleTree by Hilton London - Docklands Riverside*
